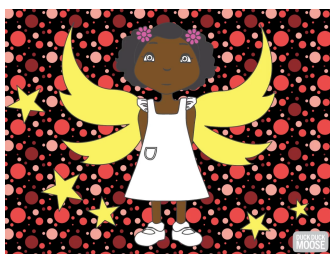

SUMMARY:

Draw & Tell HD is an image creation app designed for young artists. Users have a choice to color existing images, create their own drawings, or design mini-animations with voiceover and movable “stickers” as well as a variety of backgrounds, stencils, & colors.

ELA: Students can draw responses to read alouds, create mini-animations to retell a story, or even create images to pull into other apps (e.g., Book Creator) for writing their own stories.
