Search: You no longer have to swipe all the way to the right to get the search bar. Changes in Safari

- 1. **Share Button Change** This used to be the "jumping arrow" but now it's been updated and combined with other features.
- 2. **Swipe to navigate** You now have the ability to go back and forth in history on your webpage by either swiping from to the right from the left edge or swiping to the left from the right edge of the screen.
- 3. **Unified search and address bar** The search and address bar have been combined into one "Smart Search" bar.
- **4. Offline Reading -** If you are on a cluttered webpage and just want to see the content of an article, a little offline •

reading button appears after the full webpage loads. Click on it and you have an instant uncluttered page.
