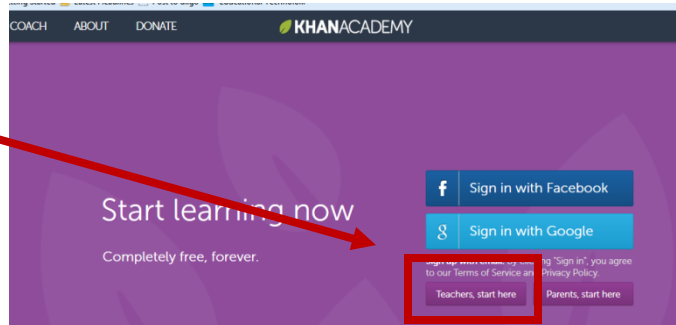


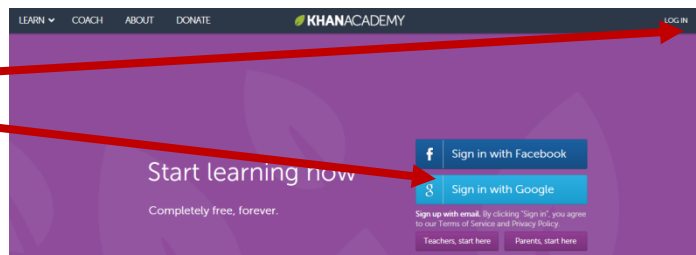

Create Your Class in Khan Academy

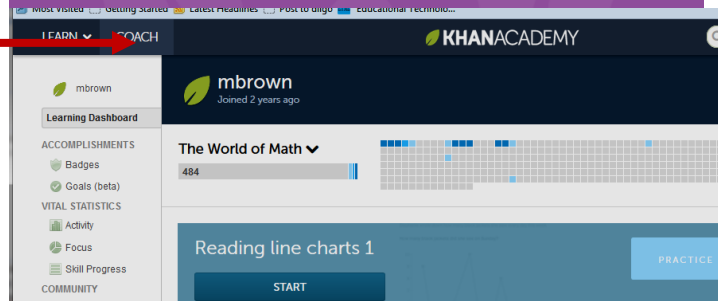
If you don't have an account, click the Teachers Start Here button.



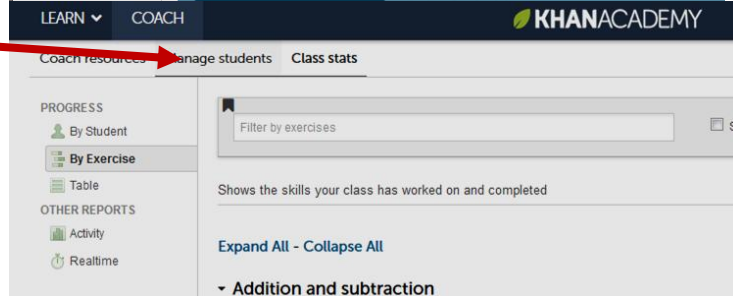
If/ When you do have an account Log in to Khan Academy with your Khan account, or Google Account or Facebook Account



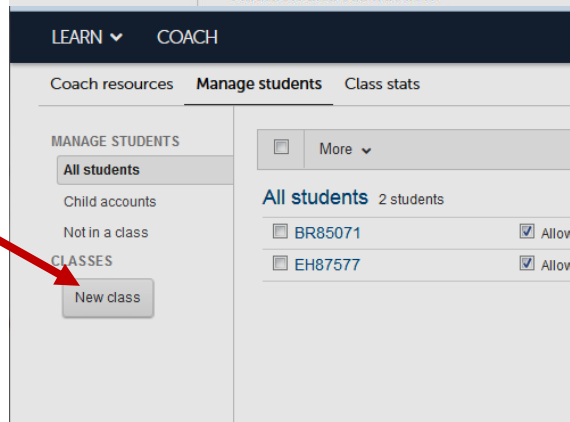
Click the Coach Tab



Click Manage Students



Click New Class



Give your class a name

and click create class.

You can invite students to your class using their gmail account.

After you have added the student gmail addresses click Invite students

Or, you can use a code in which Students Log in to Khan Academy with their Gmail Account and enter the code.

This code is generated when you create your class and appears in the window under the name of your class.

Write it on the board or under the doc camera.

This code assigns you as their coach and you can monitor their progress the same way as if you entered their email addresses.

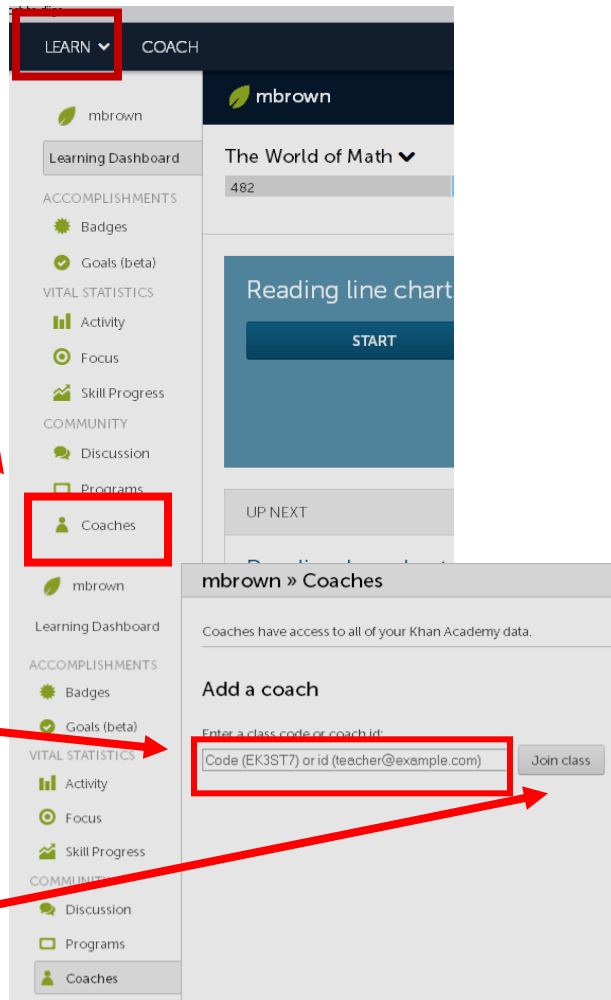

When students log in, they need to be sure the “LEARN” tab is chosen.

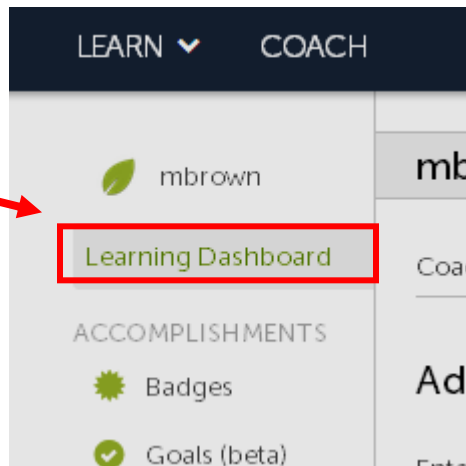
Students Touch the Coaches link at the bottom of the list under the Learning Dashboard

Students enter your class code in the box.

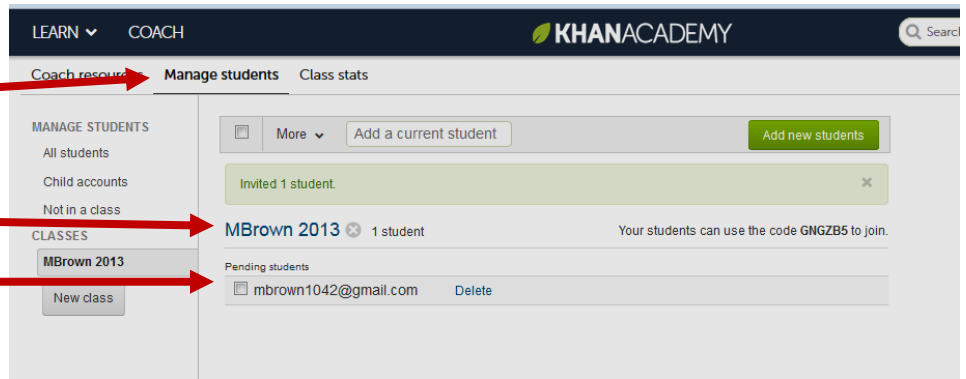
Then Touch “Join Class”.

From the Manage Students Tab on your login, you will be able to monitor progress.

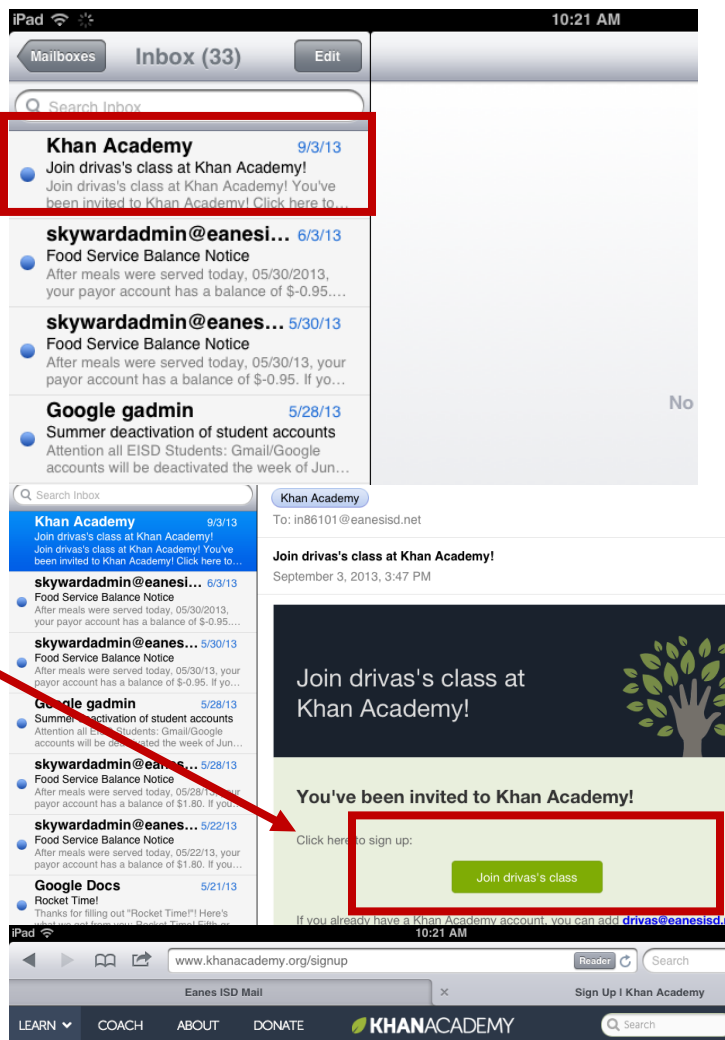

Click the Google Box to log in.

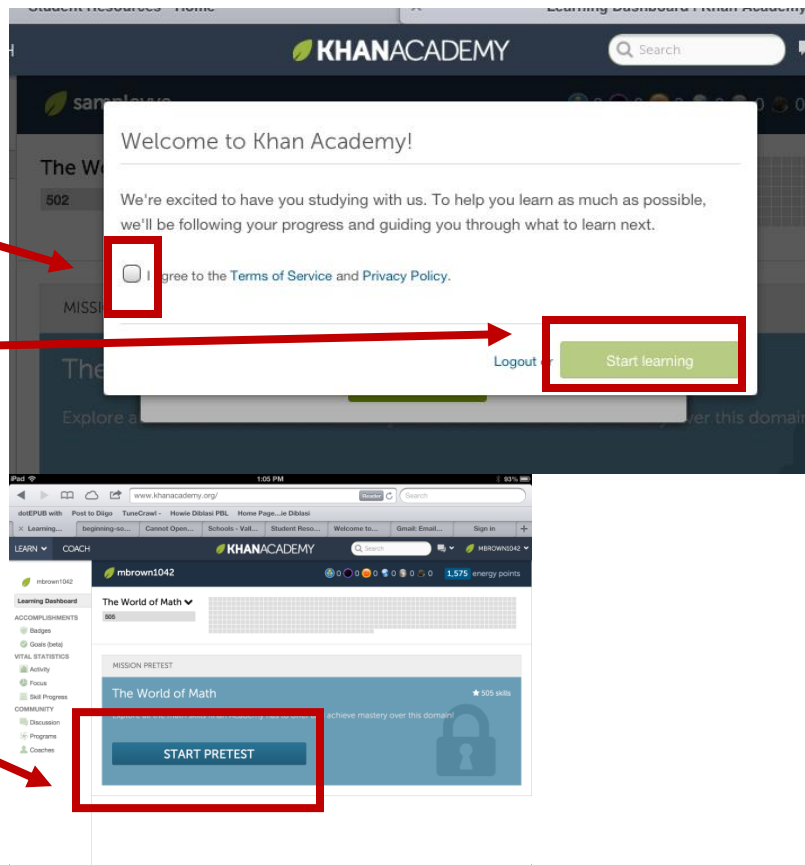

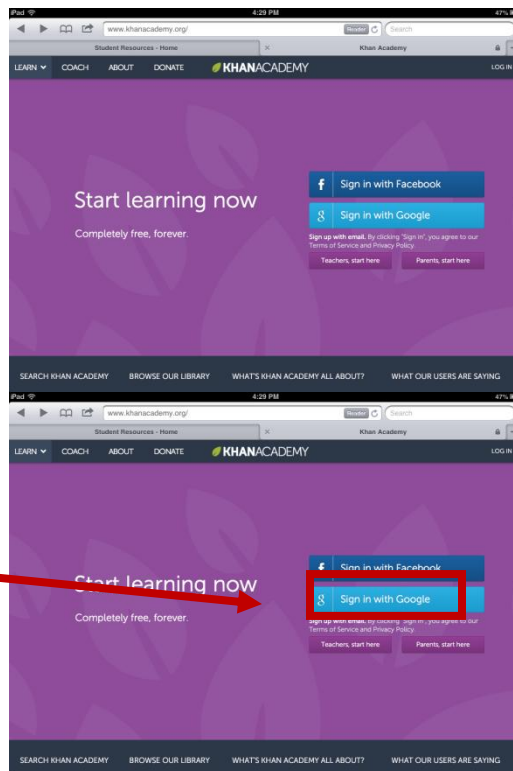


When Using Khan Academy on the iPad After the Initial Login, Using the Safari Browser is Suggested

Safari browser and logs in.

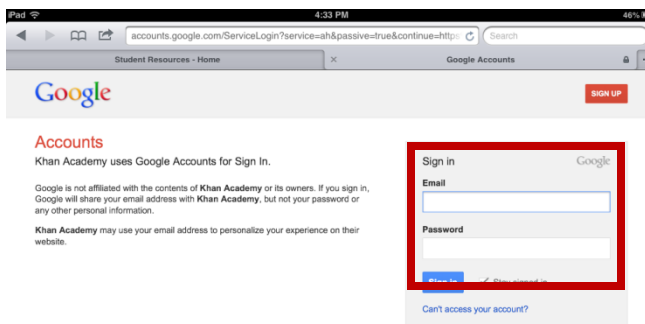
Note: creating a button on the home screen

Student should select Sign in with Google

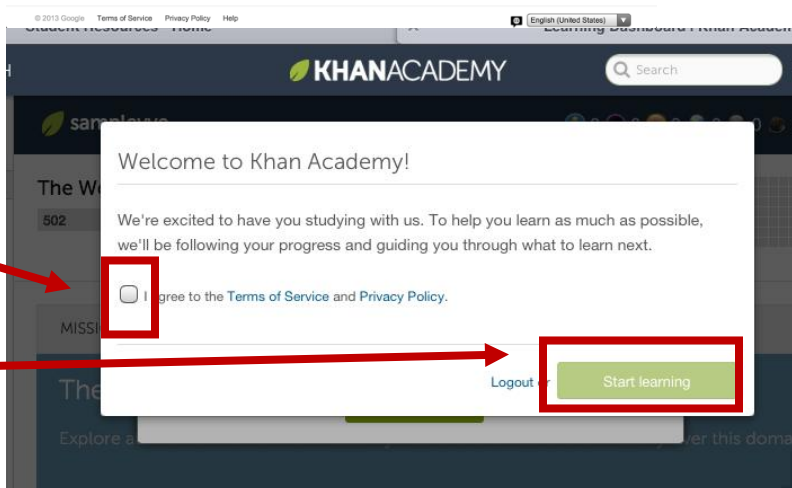


Student should use their Gmail username and password to log in.

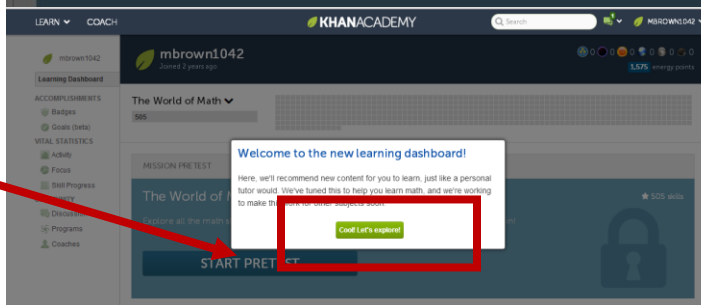

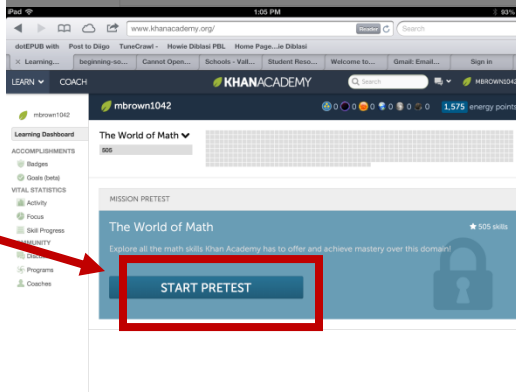

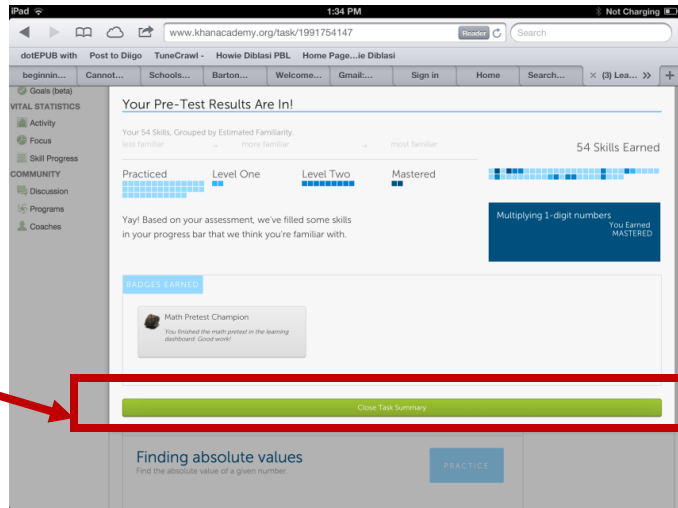

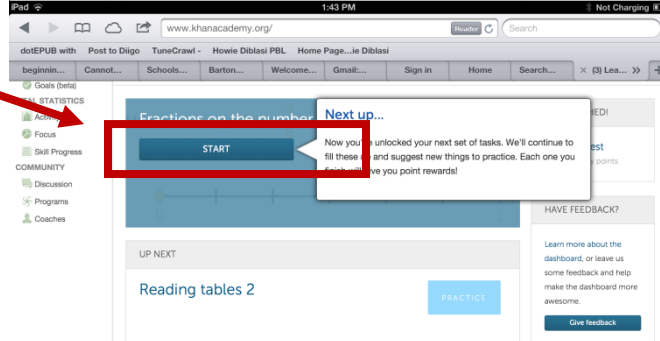


The results of the pretest will generate. The blue box on the right displays progress on the skills. This is called a Task Summary.

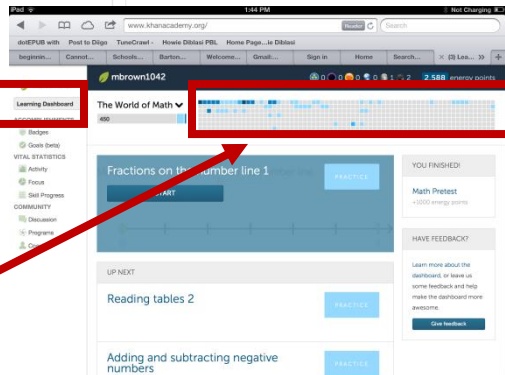
Click the Green bar at the bottom to proceed.



Click to start your set of tasks.



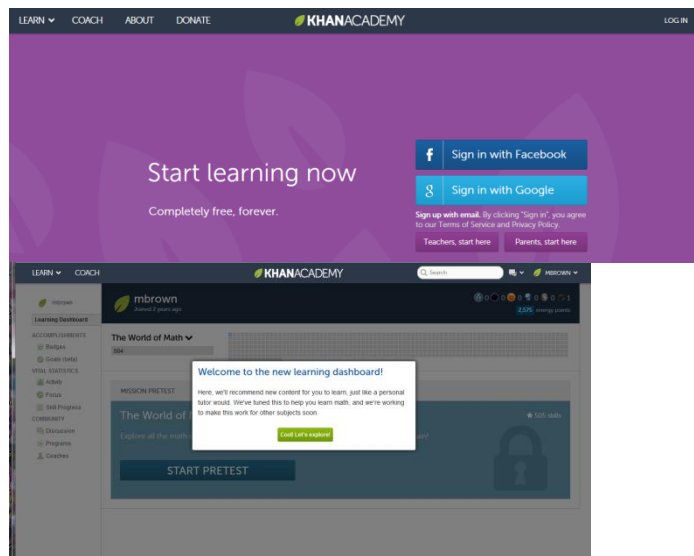
Click Learning Dashboard to select skills to work on and to view progress.



The graph on top displays the items you are working on, and have mastered.

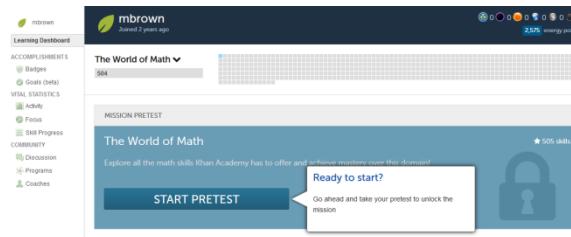

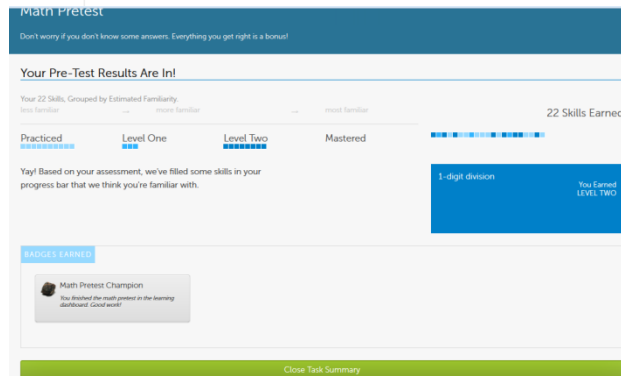
