•Let students take photos of their projects and label


• Open the App from the PRODUCTIVITY folder and choose LABEL BOX



• The first time it opens, you may get push notification and location alerts, choose NO or DON'T ALLOW. A welcome screen and a tutorial will follow.



- The main menu is at the bottom of the screen. Choose IMPORT PHOTO and ALLOW ACCESS if prompted. Choose a photo from your camera roll or take a new photo.
 - You can change the aspect ratio or take a photo in landscape or portrait mode.



- Once the photo loads, press the ribbon, stamp, or cloud icon and choose a style.
- Press and drag on your picture where you want the label to go.
- Press the X to delete it or use the rotation icon to stretch or rotate it.
 - You cannot edit the words you type. Just delete the ribbon and start over.
 - To move the label ribbon just press and drag it.





- Press the SHARE SQUARE and choose SAVE IMAGE to save it to your camera roll.
- To start a new project, press the camera icon and start over again.
