

Accounts: The teacher uploads the presentation to the Nearpod website from any computer to his/her account. To share with students the teacher opens the App on his/her ipad and shares the code with the students. Students open the app and enter the code the teacher shared with them to view the presentation.

Publishing and Sharing: The content is hosted on the Nearpod site and can only be accessed with the code that you share with your students. It can be viewed with the app, or online.

## **SUMMARY:**

Nearpod allows teachers to construct presentations using the <u>Nearpod website</u> and deliver instruction to students by pushing content out to multiple devices at once. The teacher controls the presentation from a master iOS device, while students follow along on a class set of iPads or iPods. To enliven instruction, teachers can also embed multiple choice questions, polls, videos, quizzes, open-ended questions, and web-links in their presentations.

1. Create a presentation in Keynote

or Powerpoint.



2. Export as a PDF File.



3. Login into NearPod.

4. Click on Create



5. Click the New Presentation icon.



6. Drag your PDF files into the box.



7. Customize your presentation by giving it a suitable name and description.



8. Start adding interactive content by clicking the Add button.



9. Choose an interactive feature to add by double clicking it. Then add appropriate etc.

Click Save when done. Repeat this to add all your interactive content. You can drop slides around to re-order.



10. Once you have completed your presentation click Done.



11. In order to share use you presentation you need to publish it (be aware that once published you cannot edit the presentation unless you clone it) .Once you have selected the presentation click the Publish button.



12. Open your Nearpod teacher app on your iPad. Select your presentation and launch it once you have signed into the app. Your students need to launch the Nearpod student app. Give them the pin number display on your App. You now take them through the interactive presentation.
