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SUMMARY:

Puppet Pals 2: School Edition is a storytelling app students can use to create narratives. Users select backgrounds, add actors/props/music, pose and move characters while recording voices, and even add their own camera-roll images. Once complete, users can save their video and share multiple ways (e.g., email, to Seesaw Learning, Showbie, Google Classroom, or even import into iMovie).

ELA: Students can create & share narrative, expository, persuasive, or descriptive writing. Combine writing elements (e.g., storyboarding, grammar, text elements) and oral language use to prepare and present the show!

Math: Students can import images of math concepts and use their puppets to explain the concept to a classmate or even a younger audience.
